## 2. Nominations to the Governing Body of Limerick Institute of Technology

The Chief Executive advised that the ETB has been directed by the Department to nominate as many as possible to the Governing Body of LIT in advance of August 31st 2016.

Members noted that the ETB has already nominated three persons to the Governing Body i.e. Mr. Tony Brazil, Cllr. Elena Secas and Mr. Sean McMahon with the fourth nominee to be nominated at its September meeting following replacement of Senator Maria Byrne.

The Board was advised that the Institute of Taxation has declined to nominate a person to the Governing Body and that the Academic Council of LIT has appointed the Shannon Group as the replacement nominating body. The Shannon group has yet to submit its nomination and the Board decided to fill the vacancies at its next Board Meeting.

The Chief Executive advised Members that in completing the nomination process the board must take cognizance of the following:

- a) Gender balance a minimum of seven of the nominees must be female and a minimum of seven must be male.
- b) A minimum of three ETB nominees must be serving counsellors on the local authority.
- c) Any nominee of the Board should not be a serving member of the Board of the ETB and the board of another nominating body.
