a Creative Youth Festival around the Shannon Estuary

Join us on for Call & Response 2022, our third annual festival, celebrating youth creativity in Limerick and Clare. Dance, drama, visual art, music and cultural gatherings are at the core of this year's events – all of which are designed based on the voice of the young person. Participants and audiences can enjoy new murals in Pallasgreen, Askeaton and Rathkeale as well as outdoor exhibitions in Ennis and Limerick City.

For the first time, our festival foregrounds the voice of the very young child through INSPIRE, our early years programme, initiated in partnership with Clare County Childcare Committee and Limerick Childcare Committee in 2019. In Clare, very young children will hear recordings of their peers' voices through workshops in Clare County Library branches. In Limerick, Naíonra na nÓg Pre-School, Caherdavin open their doors to very limited audiences who can observe some of our dance and movement workshops.

A Teenage Gathering in glór, a radio play premiere, created by young people from Dóchas Midwest, a work-in-progress drama in the Belltable, a clay workshop in the Hunt Museum, a dance jam in Dance Limerick and a new music video for Abbeyfeale's 'Succeed' crew add to the multidisciplinary mix that makes up an exciting programme of work.

Sincere thanks to our funding partners who enable this work to happen, to our collaborators from the youth and cultural sectors, and the many community and voluntary organisations who support our work.

Supported by Pallasgreen Templebraiden Community Council and led by youth leader Stephen O'Neill, this ambitious public art project received funding from the National Youth Council of Ireland, Limerick Arts Office, Ballyhoura Development Company as well as core funding from the Local Creative Youth Partnership who co-managed the project with Pallasgreen Youth Club.

The community party will include food and music with performances from Pallasgreen's emerging young musicians.



During periods of lockdown in 2021 and 2022, members of this group worked with Local Creative Youth Partnership Tutor and theatre maker John Hogan to devise and perform a script which was recorded at the Learning Hub in Kileely, Community Focus presenter, Ger Leddin will chat to some of the young participants from this project about how they came up with the idea and turned it into a radio drama. The Spectrum and The Game is just ten minutes long and is set in a gaming shop on a morning when a new game is due to go on sale. A very excited young girl ventures into the shop to enquire about the game and is met with a none too pleasant experience.

## Shape the Clay Taster Workshop

Hunt Museum, Saturday October 1st, 11.00am to 1pm

Experimentation in clay is the order of the day during this workshop. Young people can try their hand at coil building, a foundational and ancient skill used since the Neolithic Stone Age period to create pottery vessels. They will also explore and get to grips with the Ancient Greek's graffito technique, a method of scratching away painted clay to create popping images, patterns and textures. All materials are supplied but participants should bring an apron or wear old clothes.




## Launch of Outdoor Exhibition
