
Young visual artists from Rathkeale start off our festival on Culture Night with a new exhibition of work, Outside World, on the railings of Limerick's People's Park and in The People's Museum of Limerick. A second exhibition XPRESS, a new collection of print works by young people from diverse youth clubs in Limerick City, opens on September 25th, marking a new partnership with Limerick Island Community Partners whose gallery space on 19 Nicholas St. offers new possibilities for youth and community groups.

Together with our partners in Dance Limerick and Limerick Childcare Committee, we are very excited to announce the newly commissioned baby dance show, INSPIRE: Magic, premiering October 1st in Dance Limerick. On the other side of the Shannon, our colleagues in <u>Clare County Childcare</u> Committee and Clare Library help us launch audio recordings of stories from the oral tradition.

For theatre lovers, Kilkee Youth Theatre's teenage members return to Cultúrlann Sweeney with their hilarious version of The Hysterical History of the Trojan War with our expert drama tutors holding an open workshop for new and existing members. In Limerick City, young people from Limerick Youth Service's Nicholas St. Youth Space bring back an excerpt from *The Parish*, an intergenerational theatre event which had a sell-out run in St. Mary's in July.

This exhibition replaces A Day in the Life of Rathkeale, a photographic exhibition also created by young people from Rathkeale, which has been in place since 2020. 

Music Video Launch – 12 Noon Friday 29th



INSPIRE **BABY MOVEMENT** AND DANCE

An aim to hear the voice of the very young child through non-verbal communication has been the impetus behind the LCYP's INSPIRE: Baby Movement and Dance programme. Over the past four years, we have worked closely with Limerick Childcare Committee, Dance Limerick and with Early Learning Educators to this end. This year, artist and LCYP tutor, Aoife McGarry spent several months in residence in Nursery Times and Childworld early learning centres in Limerick, sharing and exchanging some of her ideas with babies under two years of age.
